- *Ensuring control of outsourced processes, through supplier approval, ongoing evaluation and performance monitoring, particularly for critical activities such as surface treatments and subcontracted special processes.*
- *Promoting continual improvement and innovation, encouraging the optimisation of production processes, digitalisation, the introduction of new manufacturing technologies and the renewal of equipment where necessary.*
- *Developing personnel competence, by promoting training, multi-skilling, active participation and awareness of quality, safety and process improvement.*
- *Promoting a safe working environment, safeguarding the health, safety and wellbeing of workers.*
- *Managing the organisation efficiently, ethically and responsibly, optimising costs and resources in order to ensure the sustainability and profitability of the business.*
- *Integrating environmental, social and governance criteria — ESG — into the company's management, promoting the efficient use of resources and the reduction of environmental impact.*
